

Applications for Short Courses open 1 September 2016 – 15 January 2017.

Eligibility Criteria – COTE D'IVOIRE

- National of Côte d'Ivoire
- Mid to senior level professionals working in the Public Sector, the Private Sector or a Non-Government Organisation (Civil Society) in one of the listed priority fields of study.
- At least 25 and not more than 50 years of age at the date of application
- At least three (3) years' post-graduation work experience in a relevant policy, practice, researcher reform role. Preference will be given to candidates with greater periods of experience.
- Gender Equality: Australia Awards target equal participation by women and men.
- Disability Inclusion: Australia Awards aim to ensure that people with a disability are given fair and equal opportunity to compete for and obtain a scholarship.
